<p>19 November 2018</p> <p>425 MONITORING SHEET</p> <p>RECOMMENDED (to the Regeneration and Property Committee) that a clear written response as to how the council's actions met the terms of the Community Governance Review be provided.</p>	<p>When the Community Governance Review recommendations were approved by Council it was agreed that there would be a review of its implementation prior to the new Council in May 2019.</p> <p>This item will be removed from the monitoring sheet January 2020.</p>
<p>March 2019</p> <p>708 Annual Parking Review</p> <p>The Chairman introduced the proposals and points of clarification were made where necessary. The Forum agreed by general assent to recommend to the Joint Transportation Board that all of the officers' recommendations be agreed with the following exceptions:</p> <p>2530 Hever Place and Wichling Close - Amend - implement the proposals in relation to double yellow lines but consult on alternative options for time restrictions that allow school drop off but prevent all day parking.</p> <p>700 Lady Wootton's Green and Church Street (St Paul's) - Amend - implement to Lady Wootton's Green only</p> <p>A member of the public also raised concerns about the parking permit system. Following a discussion and vote, it was Recommended to officers that 'the city centre parking system be overhauled and that the matter be considered at a future meeting of the Forum'.</p>	<p>The recommendations were discussed by Joint Transportation Board on 21 March 2019 and were agreed as per the recommendations.</p> <p>This item has been resolved and will be removed from the monitoring sheet March 2020.</p> <p>This item is currently under consideration by officers and an update will be provided when available.</p>
<p>June 2019</p> <p>52 Introduction to the Forum</p> <p>It was proposed, seconded and when put to a vote unanimously agreed that a 20 minute question time item be included on future Canterbury Forum agendas.</p>	<p>This item has been resolved and will be removed from the monitoring sheet June 2020.</p>

<p>June 2019</p> <p>56 - Preparation for the integrated transport hub discussion</p> <p>It was proposed, seconded and when put to a vote unanimously agreed that the transport hub meeting should be a large event, open to all stakeholders and that it should be held at the Westgate Hall.</p>	<p>The request for the transportation stakeholder event has been passed to the Regeneration and Property Committee for consideration.</p>
<p>June 2019</p> <p>57 - Monitoring sheet</p> <p>It was agreed by general assent that the monitoring sheet contains items that have been to the forum for the rolling period of 12 months.</p>	<p>This item has been resolved and will be removed from the monitoring sheet June 2020.</p>
<p>14 January 2019 September 2019</p> <p>CYCLING IN THE HIGH STREET</p> <p>It was agreed that the Chairman would write to the food delivery companies to highlight safety concerns.</p>	<p>The Chairman had written to the food delivery companies and had received a positive reaction.</p> <p>This item was due to be removed from the monitoring sheet January 2020, but following further discussions at the Canterbury Forum in September 2019, it was agreed that the Chairman would again write to the food delivery companies.</p> <p>This item will be removed from the monitoring sheet September 2020.</p>
