

## PROPOSED WHITSTABLE HARBOUR CHARGES – 2020/21

Canterbury City Council being the Harbour Authority for Whitstable Harbour have determined by virtue of the powers conferred upon them under Section 26 of the Harbours Act 1964 that the dues and fees payable at Whitstable Harbour in respect of ships, goods and services provided shall from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 be as follows:
